

Exploring Article 8 in the film archive

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My research to date

- Exploring whether Article 8 can be successfully implemented in film archives
- Ethnographic research of 2 film archives in the UK and 2 in the Netherlands to date (with a primary focus on the BFI and EYE)
- Current practices within film archives and their current approaches to copyright, to explore whether (and how) out of commerce works could be utilised





Preliminary themes: functional or core issues

- There is no representative CMO for film
- Archives having at least a partial commercial aspect vital to their funding structure
- A strong desire not to cause potential reputational harm with current or future donors (either financial or material)
- Funding and issues such as technology obsolesce and material degradation are of a more urgent nature for some archives



Preliminary themes: implementation issues

- Concern that the "reasonable effort" requirement is akin to the cumbersome "diligent search"
- Lack of clarity about what works would be out of commerce, a desire from some archives to have clear cut off dates
- Lack of clarity/ difference of opinion of what purposes would be "non-commercial", and particularly which websites are "non-commercial"





Preliminary themes: contextual issues

- A 'backlog' in the archives of un-catalogued or un-accessioned items
- Concern that it would be a substantial financial and staffing effort to ascertain the copyright status of the works
- The UK CHIs have a more risk-adverse approach than in the Netherlands
