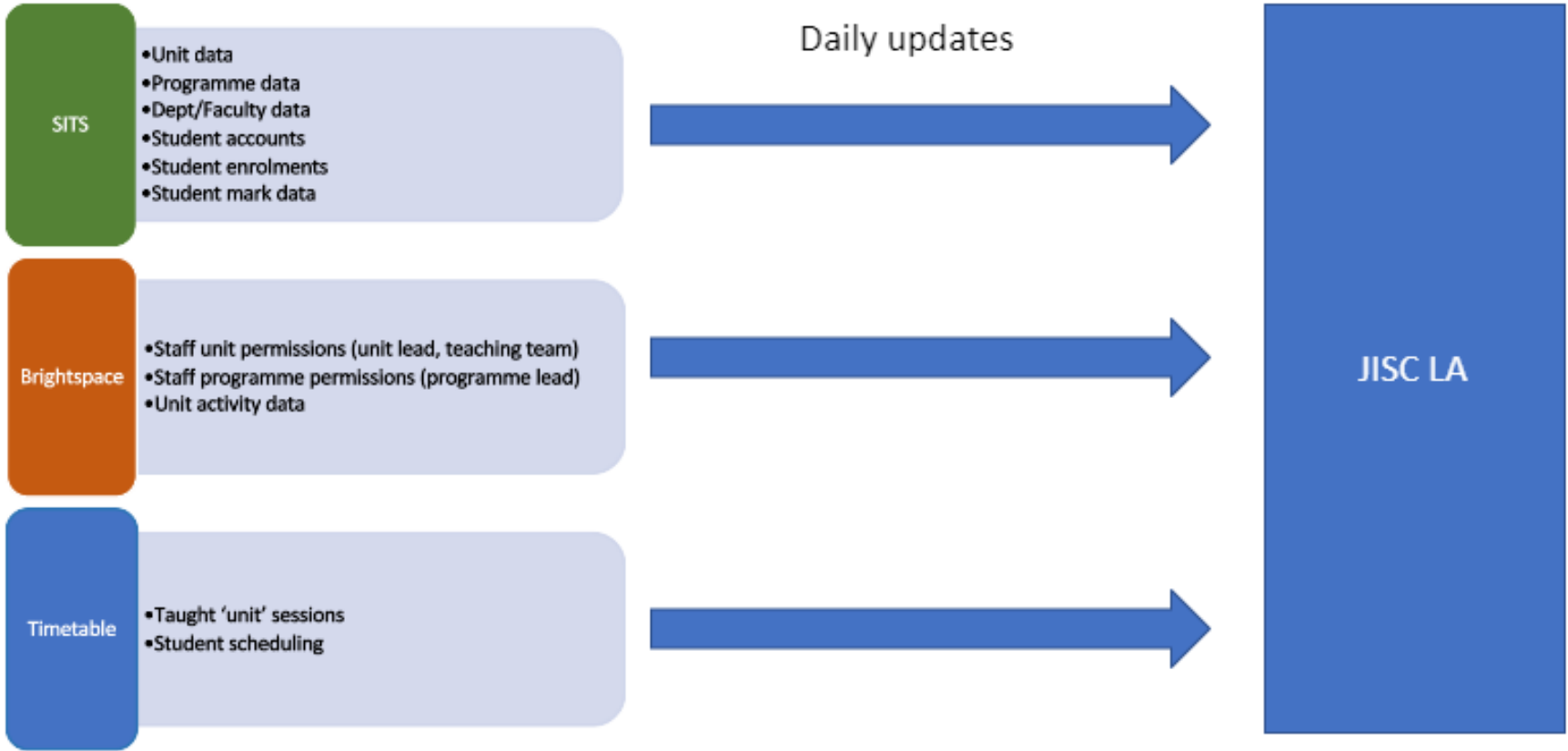


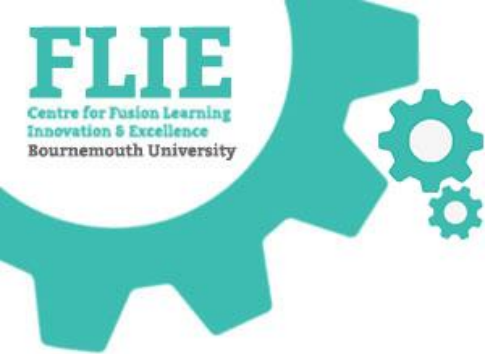
What is it?

Unit Leads and Teaching Team

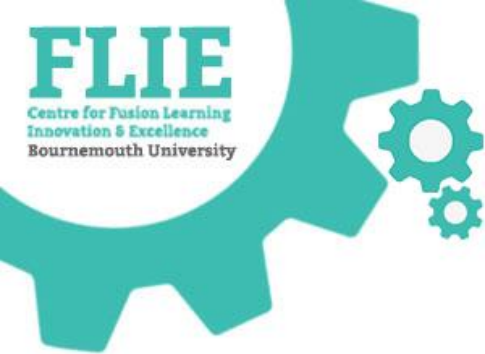
- Check you are correctly enrolled as Unit Lead or Teaching Team on **Brightspace units**

Programme Leads

- Check your listed programmes via the **Programmes tile**

Level Tutors / Programme Coordinators

Will need to be set as Programme Lead in the programme area on Brightspace

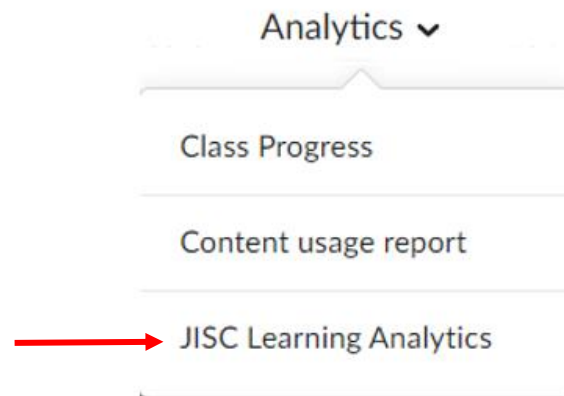


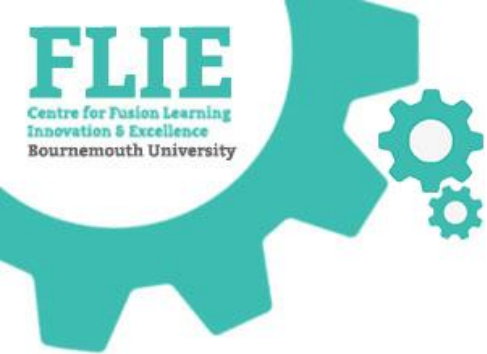

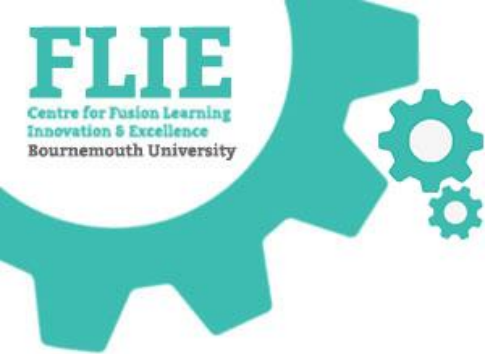

ATTENDANCE CAPTURE

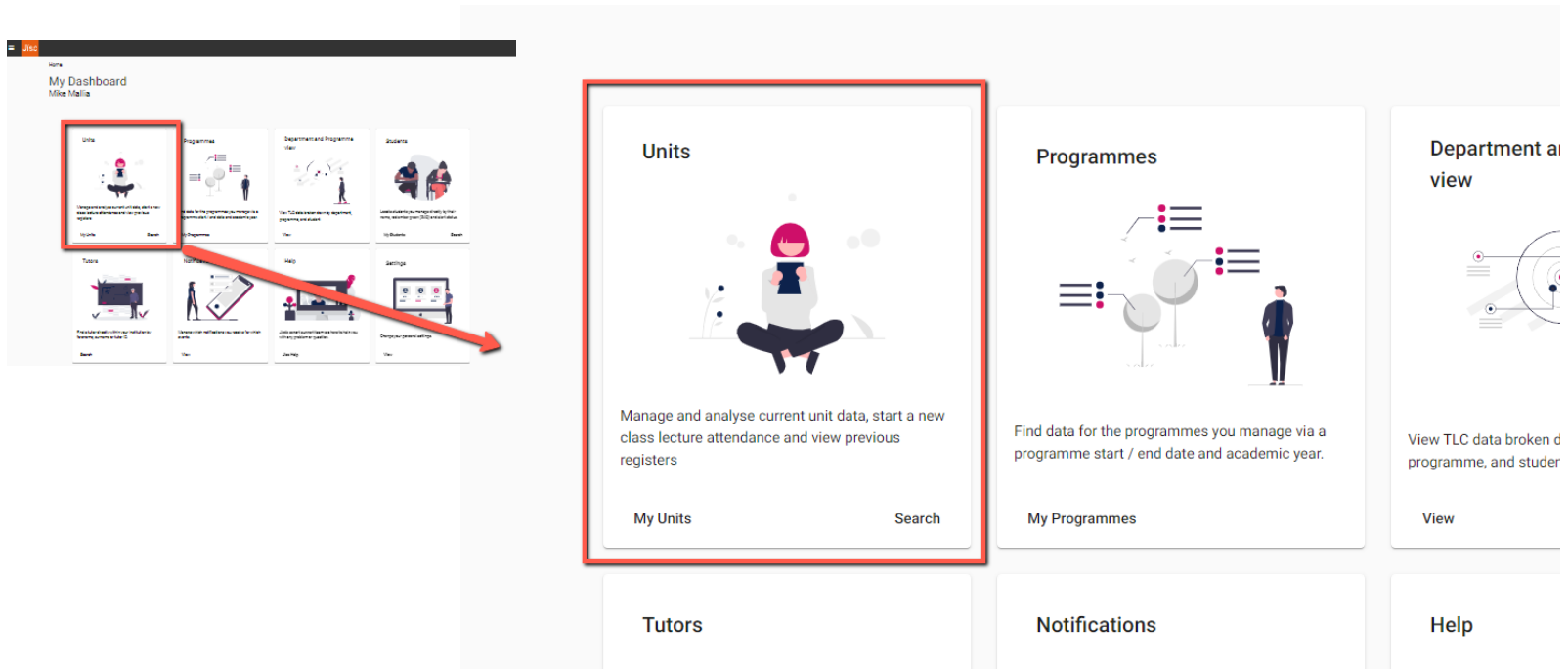


Attendance capture

- Attendance can be captured for timetabled events that are associated with a curricular unit
- Attendance for other timetabled or non-timetabled events cannot be recorded
- Code is only valid for **one hour**

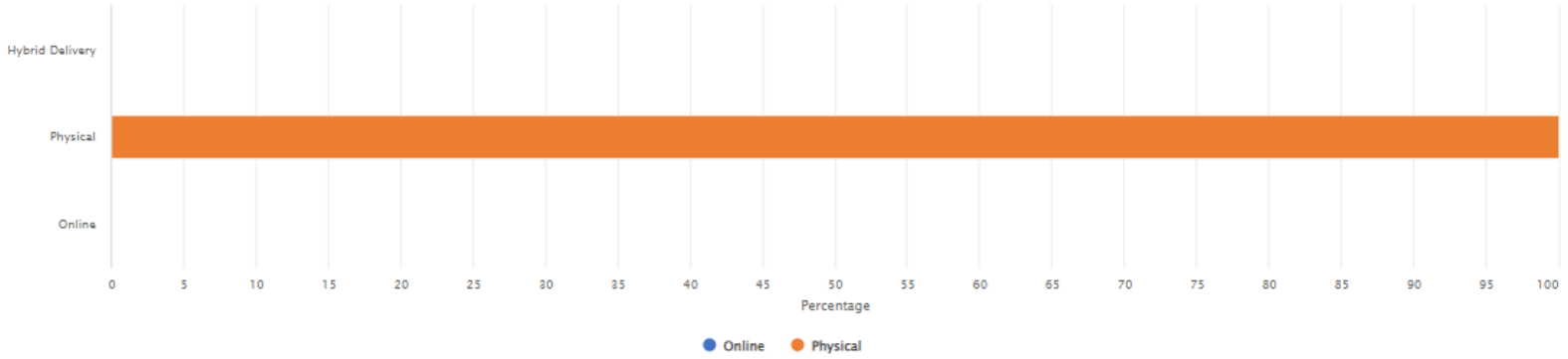

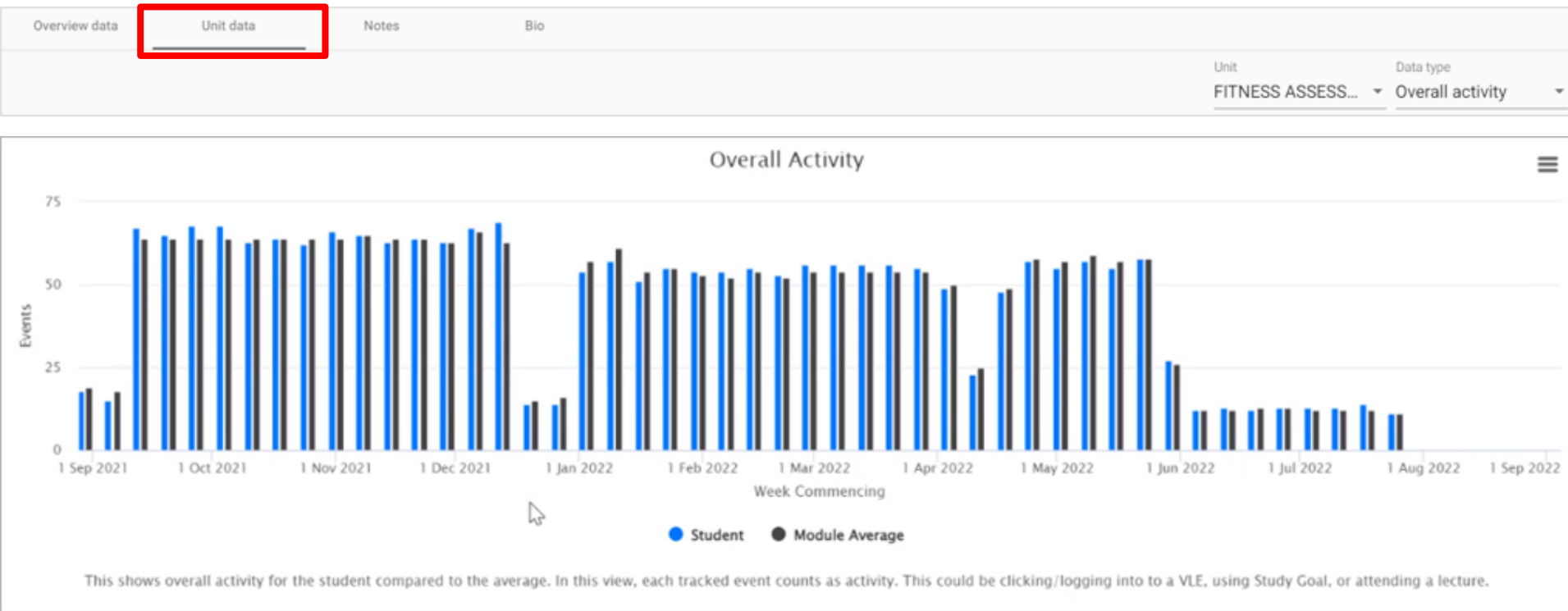

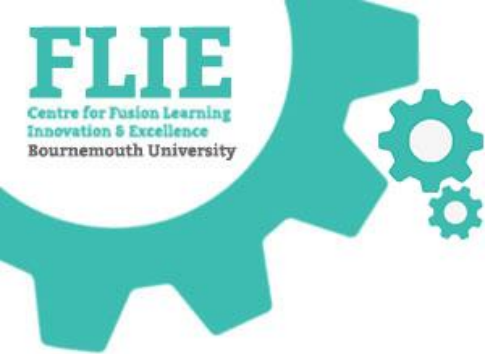

Good to know

- Withdrawn students are removed from the data set
- If there is no attendance data, this is ignored in the RAG status
- Attendance is only calculated for registers that have been started
- There are no RAG statuses on inactive units

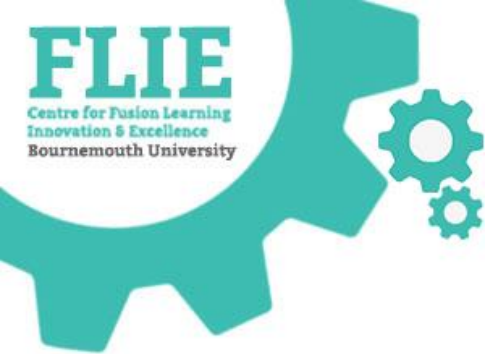

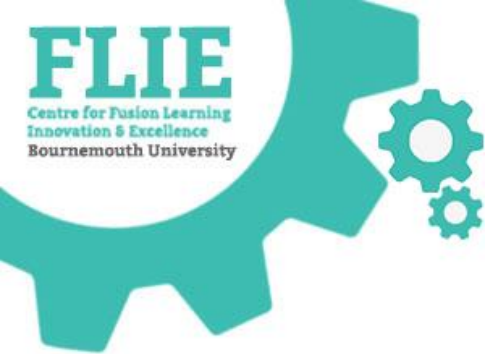
