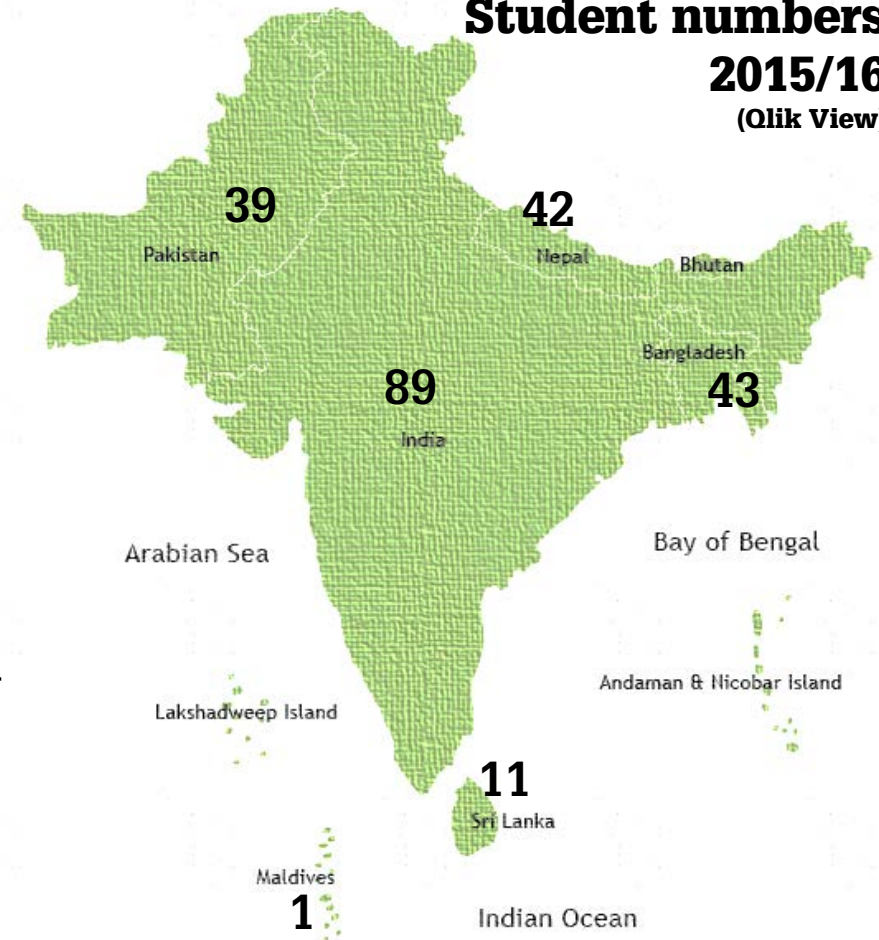
BU on the Indian subcontinent
